## - General ADA Sign Regulations

Below is a general list of regulations concerning the fabrication of ADA signs. ADA signage guidelines are primarily intended to make facilities accessible to the blind, visually-impaired, and mobility impaired. All public facilities must take steps to comply with ADA regulations. This is strictly a general list. Please consult local building codes for any particular regulations that may not be covered here.

- ADA signs must be placed outside of all permanent rooms and spaces in a public building. Permanent rooms and spaces are generally defined as room numbers, exit signs, and restrooms signs
- Sign background color and letter/number/pictograph color must have a $70 \%$ contrast
- Sign finish must be non-glare
- All text/numbers must be a san-serif font and upper case only. Characters shall not be italic, oblique, script, highly decorative, or of other unusual forms
- Text/number height must be a minimum of $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ tall
- All raised text/numbers must have corresponding Grade Il braille $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ below and centered

Below are general guidelines for the installation and mounting of ADA signs. Be certain to check with State and local building codes and your inspector before installing ADA signs.

ADA signs are to be mounted so that the baseline of the tactile characters is no less than 48 inches, and no more than 60 inches, from the floor. All signs should be placed on the wall adjacent to the latch side of the door if construction allows. The sign must be placed so that a person may approach within three inches of the sign without encountering protruding objects or standing within the swing of the door.
